Garden Checklist

1. Keep azalea roots moist and add more peat moss or ground bark to maintain an even 2-inch mulch. Feed plants now with the complete acid fertilizer your nurseryman recommends. 2. Prune out broken branches and deadwood from fruit trees now. They're easy to spot when the tree is in leaf. Continue to irrigate deeply at long, regular intervals.

3. This is an excellent time to set out evergreen shrubs. Your local C.A.N. nurseryman has a large stock of polished evergreens such as camellias, hollies, viburnums and boxwood. The evergreen viburnums have many different landscape uses. extremely fragrant flowers, and all have handsome

4. Set out small plants of calendulas (Pot Marigolds) now for bloom before Christmas. The Pacific Beauty strains have fine clear shades of yellows and oraiges. They don't need rich soil, but give them good drainage.




