

Thomas Pushes San Pedro Park for College Locale

Following meetings this week with the Los Angeles County Department of Parks and Recreation and consulting engineers and architects hired by the Board of Trustees of the California State Colleges, prospects brightened still further for early selection of a Palos Verdes State College site, Assemblyman Vincent Thomas said today.

"In order to expedite early completion of the feasibility studies required by the Trustees I instructed my Administrative Assistant, Walter Harvey, to arrange and attend meetings between County Parks and Recreation, P.V. State College staff, and consultants appointed by the Trustees.

"Mr. Harvey's efforts have been most productive," Thomas continued, "and Norman Johnson, director of County Parks and Recreation, and Parks Superintendent Ronald Paige have expressed complete willingness to cooperate with the State and the College Trustees in making San Pedro's Friendship Park available on a reasonable basis.

"In my opinion this has resulted in a significant step forward for the Friendship Park site," Thomas emphasized, "and I have instructed my administrative assistant to contact the appropriate officials in Torrance to offer similar assistance regarding that site. In addition, Thomas went on, "the consultants have been notified that the facilities of my office are available to them at any time to help resolve any problems pertaining to their report."

At the August meeting of the Trustees in Los Angeles Thomas stated that in his opinion the Legislature would be most responsive to any requests for additional funds for site acquisition and college support if the chosen site lay within the original delineated service area.
