ORDINANCE NO. 1634
AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE PROHIBITING THE ISSUANCE OF A BUILDING PERMIT FOR ANY BUILDING ON LOT 22 TRACT NO. 2886, UNTIL PENDING ZONE CHANGE PROCEEDINGS HAVE BEEN COMPLETED, AND DECLARING THE PRESENCE OF AN EMERGENCY.
 WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines as follows:
 (1) The present zoning of said property (R-2) is not compatible with the property in the immediate area, which has been developed with single-family dwellings and is in fact spot zoning normally considered improper.
 (2) Preliminary plans have been presented to the Building Department for the construction of a multiple-family unit on the subject property.
 (3) The Planning Commission, at its regular meeting of November 4, 1965, moved to initiate hearings from R-2 to R-3 on the subject property, thereby making it compatible with existing zoning in the neighborhood.
 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Torrance, California, does ordain as follows:
SECTION 1.
 That the Superintendent of Building and Safety and all other officers and employees of the Department of Building and Safety are hereby ordered and directed not to issue any permits for the construction of any building on said Lot 22 Tract 2886, until zoning proceedings on said property have been completed.
SECTION 2.
 That the Planning Commission is hereby ordered and directed to file all speed consonant with law in processing said zoning proceeding on said lot.
SECTION 3.
 That the City Council hereby declares this Ordinance to be an emergency measure for the reason stated in the above findings of fact, the immediate adoption and the immediate presentation of the Ordinance to the City Council is necessary for the protection of the public peace, health, and safety and the proper functioning of City Government.
 This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after the passage and adoption thereof and the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause the same to be published once in the Torrance-Press-Herald, a semi-weekly newspaper and circulated in the City of Torrance.
