Mayor Clyde Bernhardt will signal the start of the second annual Christmas in Lomita program tomorrow when he lights a big Christmas tree at Lomita Park.

The program will begin at 7:30 with the Veterans of Foreign Wars posting the colors. All churches and civic organizations in Lomita have been invited to participate in the program.

Monday's events will include a presentation by the PTA Singing Mothers of Lomita School and an appearance by Santa Claus. The Lomita Junior Chamber of Commerce will present its awards to winners of the home decoration contest.

Tuesday's program will be opened by the Rev. Joel Rivers at 7 p.m. Christmas story readings will be given by members of the Lomita Missionary Church and choirs from the Wayside Methodist Church, Calvary Assembly of

God, and Narbonne Avenue Baptist Church will sing special Christmas music. The Rev. Hubert Lagasse will close the program with a prayer and refreshments will be served.

Wednesday is Children's Night. A marionette show will begin at 7 o'clock and Santa Claus will pay a second visit to Lomita Park to hand out surprises to the youngsters.

Thursday will be Youth Caroling Night. Groups will leave Lomita Park at 7 p.m. to sing traditional Christmas carols throughout the city, then return about 8:30 for refreshments.
