A statewide survey showed an average 15 per cent inchease in home or property improvement loans through banks since last year at this time, Frank M. Dana, CBA president and executive vice president of the Bank of America, said most Californians who borrow for this purpose "live in houses built during the post-World War II era, and now they wish to enhance the value of their homes as their incomes have increased."

The average loan applicant has lived in his home just under 10 years.

He is the father of three children, all born since he bought the house.

Most loans are used for inside remodeling to meet the needs of a growing family—kitchen or bath remodeling and room additions including appliances.

Many applicants for loans say homes lack size, but they avoid moving.

• While most loans are used for remodeling, there are also many loans for patios, pools, carports, and miscellaneous improvements.

• The average home improvement loan is around \$1,500; in 1960 it was \$803; in 1955 it average \$583.

THE CBA president said that there is a greater interest in room additions today than there was 10 years ago, when families were smaller. "Rather than move to a larger house, loan applicants give personal reasons for staying and upgrading—they know their neighbors; they're familiar with the schools; they belong to nearby churches, and they know their own
