

Child Labor Law Protects Youth

"The thousands of boys youths from working," he said, "but is intended to protect their health and safety and to encourage them to continue their education."

Boys and girls 14 years of age and older may work part time outside of school hours in a variety of non-manufacturing jobs. The list includes such jobs as sales, maintenance, office, and clerical positions.

Young persons 16 and older may be employed part or full time in any job, including manufacturing, except those which have been declared hazardous by the Secretary of Labor. Hazardous jobs include driver, elevator operator, logger or sawmill operator, operator of power-driven machinery, and similar positions. Youths must be at least 18 years old to work at hazardous positions.

EMPLOYERS WHO plan to hire youngsters for holiday work can protect themselves from unintentional violations of the law by obtaining and keeping an age or employment certificate showing that each minor is the proper age for the job he holds. Youths usually can obtain such certificates from their schools.

All states also have child-labor laws, Muench said, and in cases where the law differs, the higher standard is enforced.
