



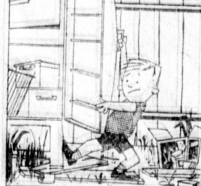

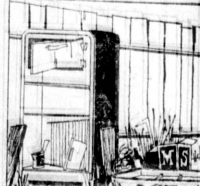

### Tartar Teen Talk

With the first half of the school year drawing to an end, I was curious to find out how our foreign exchange student likes this country. Torrance High's foreign exchange student, Ana Maria Bezerra, comes from Rio de Janeiro, Brazil.  
I asked Ana if there was one thing about our society that she liked best, but she could not think of one thing in particular. It seems that she likes everything, the progress, food, people, and everything else she has seen or done here.

WITH the holidays still fresh in our minds, I was curious about Brazilian Christmas customs. Ana tells me that Christmas there is very much like ours. Brazilians decorate their homes as we do, but they do not use outdoor lights or decorations. Here we have Santa Claus; in Brazil, they have Papa Noel. But in appearance they are the same jolly man. According to Ana, many Brazilians flock to the beaches on Christmas day. This may seem strange to us, but in Brazil, Dec. 25 is one of the hottest days of summer.  
Ana went to see the Rose Parade on New Year's Day. Her reaction? "Unbelievable! Wonderful!" She was impressed by the other viewers almost as much as by the beautiful floats. She says that everyone acted and talked like old friends, and the whole street was like a huge party or reunion.

ADJUSTING to a society different from your own is difficult. I asked Ana if there was anything in particular which she found difficult. School, she told me, was a slight problem. In Brazil, school is held from 7 a.m. until noon. Students are thus able to go home for their lunch, which is the heaviest meal of the day. Ana had a little trouble adjusting to our daily schedules which include lunch at school and heavier evening meals.  
Speaking of foods, I asked Ana if our food was different from Brazilian foods. It seems that our diet includes more sweets. Perhaps this is the reason why many exchange students find themselves gaining weight here. Ana loves our foods, and she lists pastries, Seven-up, and fudge as a few of her favorites.

Flashing red lights on a school bus require motorists traveling in either direction to stop, according to the California Highway Patrol.  
The school bus driver must activate the flashing red lights when he stops to load and unload children who must cross a highway to and from the bus, according to Bradford M. Crittenden, CHP commissioner.  
"Bus drivers are required by law to escort boys and girls across the street before boarding or after leaving their bus. Flashing red lights are not required when the bus stops for children who do not cross the roadway," the commissioner stated.
