

Watson Seeks Rehearing On School Assessments

New Unit Of Barrier Completed

Completion of another unit of the County Flood Control District's sea barrier project alnog the west coastline was announced today by Super-visor Chairman Burton W.

Chace.
The unit—identified as 2B—was built by Bowline Drilling Co., of Bakersfield, under terms of a \$71,560 contract awarded by the Board of Supervisors last August.
It involved drilling nine observation wells in EI Segundo and Manhattan Beach as part of the overall anti-brine program.

THE WELLS are located in El Segundo Boulevard, Sepulveda Boulevard, the Standard Oll Co.'s El Segundo refinery, and Santa Fe Railway right-of-way in Manhattan Beach.

The barrier project is designed to protect fresh water basins from infiltration by ocean brine. Chace said the wells reach depths from 350 to 500 feet.


