Schools Ask for New Federal Aid

Planning for an improved vocational program in Torrance may begin soon following approval of a request for \$90,000 in federal funds by the Board of Education Monday evening.

Trustees gave their approval to the request effer it was pointed out that any move toward a vocational education program in the city's high schools will require advanced planning.

"If it's going to cost \$90,000, I'd rather have federal four own operating budget," Trustee Donald E. Wilson told his colleagues.

DR. J. H. HULL, superintendent of schools, told the board the funds represent an outright grant by the federal government for planning purposes. No local funds will be required, provided the application for the funds is approved, he said.




