Viewers to Compete for Purses in New TV Show

They're off and running on KTLA! "Let's Go To The Races," a new program that combines thoroughbred horse racing from Sunshine Park in Florida and cash "purses" for home viewers, airs Thursdays at 7:30 p.m., in color on Channel 5.

Sportcaster Jack Drees calls the action at the track while KTLA's Carl McIntire hosts the pre- and post-race activities in which approximately a third of a million dollars will be given away to viewers during the next three months.

THE UNIQUE program gives the television audience an opportunity to win on the horses by playing the races right in their homes.

The feeling of actually being at the races is evident with each program filled with all the fanfare of a day at the track, including a run-down on horses, jockeys and their performance by sportscaster Drees. The producer has stationed six color cameras around the track in order to capture in minute detail each phase of the races. Home viewers play each race

by obtaining a free racing card from the program sponsor, Vons and Shopping Bag Markets, prior to each Thursday night program.

WHILE WATCHING "Let's Go To The Races," the card holder compares the winning horse of each race to the corresponding race and number on his card. When the numbers are the same, the player wins a specified cash payoff.

The "purse" for participating viewers over a three-month period totals more than \$250,000 in cash prizes. Viewers who hold cards with winners will collect on the following basis: first race, \$5; second race, \$10; third race, \$25; fourth race, \$100; fifth race, \$500.

Lucky viewers may claim their winnings from Vons and Shopping Bag Markets where a list of winning horses will be posted each week.

Church Will Present Guest Today

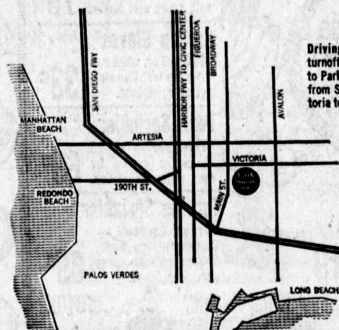
