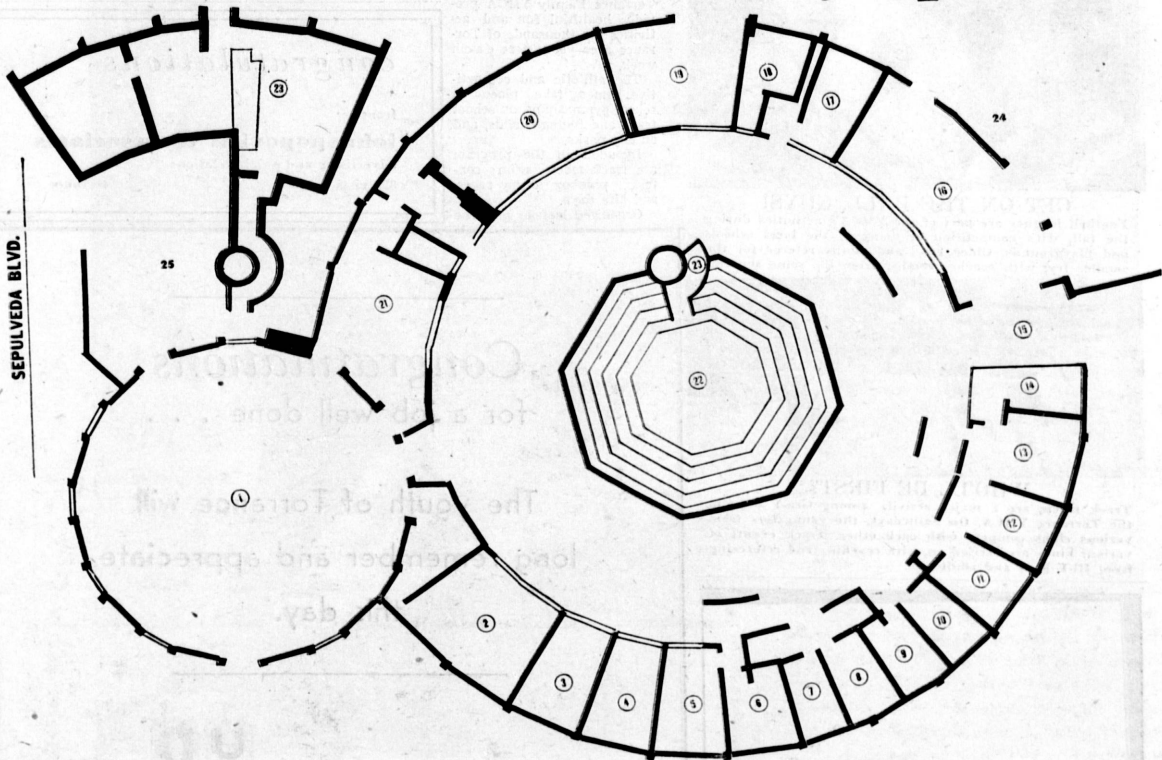


A Model of Community Spirit
