AID Cites Employes At Thrifty

AID-United Givers announced today that employes of Thrifty Drug Stores have pledged over \$116,000 for the support of major health and welfare causes for the 1965-66 fiscal year. This year's pledge is some 12 per cent more than the Thrifty group pledge last year.

In recognition of the outstanding performance of the Thrifty AID chapter, AID representative Whitney Walterhouse presented a Certificate of Commendation to Glenn Bishop, assistant vice president of Thrifty Drug Stores, and to Don Hascall, AID chairman, who received it on behalf of the chapter.

IN PRESENTING the certificate, Walterhouse said: "Through your efforts and the generosity of your employes, needed care will be extended to those who would not have been helped."

The Thrifty employes first formed an AID chapter in 1958. Since that time they have given a total of over \$570,000 through AID, including this year's pledge.

AID recently passed the \$100 million mark in collections and distributions to major health and welfare causes.

AID-UNITED GIVERS was formed in Los Angeles in 1951 by leaders of management, labor and the general public. It was organized to resolve the problem of multiple solicitation of funds for major welfare causes.

Today AID has 2,117 chapters throughout Southern California with 362,680 members. Through this group more than \$12 million annually is pledged, collected and distributed for the support of AID causes.

MAJOR HEALTH and welfare causes which are assisted by the AID program are: American Cancer Society, American Red Cross, Arthritis Foundation, City of Hope, Crippled Children's Society, Heart Association, Hospital Charity Fund, John Tracy Clinic, Multiple Sclerosis Society, United Cerebral Palsy Association, YMCA of Los Angeles, and the United Funds.

Members are privileged to designate gifts beyond the group selected by AID to their own favorite charity.

AID's cost of operation, which is 4.2 per cent of the total amount of funds collected, is recognized as the lowest in the nation.



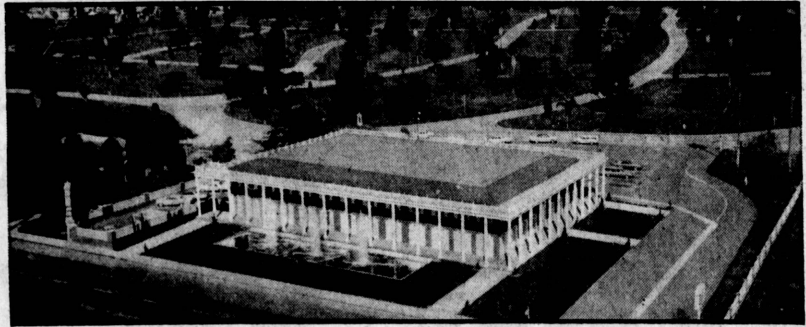
