### At Columbia School Space Probe Capsule To be Displayed Here

An Air Force Thor-Agena space probe vehicle will be displayed at Columbia School, 4502 W. 286th St., from 10 a.m. until 5 p.m. Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday.

Lester Foster, principal of the school, has invited the public to view the exhibit.

The Thor-Agena rocket combination has been used successfully many times in a continuing USAF program to gather vital research data on conditions in space.

Initial power for blast-off to great altitude is supplied by the first-stage Thor ballistic missile. When the Thor engine ceases to fire, the second-stage Agena separates and is put into desired orbit by its own rocket engine.

While in orbit, telemetering systems in the Agena instrument capsule radio back information on vehicle performance and various phenomena encountered in space. On radio command from the ground, it is possible to return the instrument capsule back to earth for further study.
