Local State Employment Office Active in 1964

The Torrance office of the California State Employment Service, 1016 Sartori Ave., placed 10,000 individuals on jobs in the Southwest during 1964. During this period more than 23,000 new registrations for work were processed.

Other services performed by the office included vocational guidance interviews with 2,300 job seekers who were having difficulty in choosing a vocation, and filling job orders placed by 1,600 employers in the area. Nearly 1,000 persons seeking employment were registered with the office Jan. 1 of this year from cities of the area which include Torrance, Gardena, Hermosa, Lomita, Harbor City, Palos Verdes Estates, Redondo Beach, Rolling Hills, Rolling Hills Estates and portions of Los Angeles City and County.

The local office urges employers to list job vacancies with the service to gain direct access to the largest single pool of qualified applicants in the community.

"All actresses seem to want to be nuns," Father Ellwood Kieser said. "I mean they want to PLAY nuns."

The young Paulist father should know what he's talking about. He's the television host and creator of the promising dramatic series "Insight," which recently made its 1965 debut. It has been his job to get the best dramatic talent for the lowest salaries.

"Insight" is no ordinary religious series. Although its budget is obvious, limited, its production crew and cast of big name stars is as professional as any in Hollywood. Among the performers are Eileen Zimbalet Jr., Jane Wymann, Edmond O'Brien, Ann Sothern, Brian Keith, Richard Egan, Paul Richards, Steve Forrest and Guy Stockwell.

One of those who plays a nun in one of the dramas is Dorothy Malone, quite a jump from her role of the unwed mother in "Peyton Place."

"Actors seem to enjoy playing men of the church," Father Kieser said. "You should have seen Raymond Massey in his Papal robes for a drama. He had a great time between shots pacing about the studio giving the Papal blessing to stage hands, the producer, other actors and anyone who would stand still long enough. And he isn't even a Catholic!"

"INSIGHT" IS NOT a Catholic recruitment series. They are problem dramas with theological, not ecclesiastical solutions.

Only about half of the stars are members of the Catholic Church, according to Father Kieser. "We are able to get good actors because the roles we offer them are gummy."

"Gummy" is a word usually avoided by the refined—and indeed I'm not sure it's even a word at all—but it appears
