St. Francis Contracts New Organ

A three-manual pipe organ, one of the largest of its kind in Southern California, will be installed in the new church building at St. Francis Episcopal upon completion in October.

Designed by Dr. Richard F. McClure, organist and

choir director at St. Francis, and Justin Kramer, of the Reuter Organ Co. of Lawrence, Kansas, the \$55,250 organ will make extensive use of exposed pipe work. One thousand of the 2,418 pipes will be exposed on the side of the chancel.

The pipes range in length from one-half inch to 16 feet. They will have a silvery appearance due to a tin and zinc composition. The stop list for the organ includes 41 ranks of pipes, which will provide myriad tonal combinations.
