ORDINANCE NO. 153
AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, ADDING SECTION 5.1 ENTITLED SALE OF UNCLAIMED BICYCLES TO CHAPTER V OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, 1954 TO PERMIT THE SALE OF UNCLAIMED BICYCLES HELD BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT THREE MONTHS. The City Council of the City of Torrance has passed the following Ordinance:

SECTION 1. That Section 5.1 entitled "Sale of unclaimed bicycles" is hereby added to "The Code of the City of Torrance, 1954" to read as follows: "Sec. 5.1. Sale of unclaimed bicycles. Notwithstanding any other section of this code, unclaimed bicycles shall be held by the police department for a period of at least three months thereafter such bicycles shall be sold at public auction to the highest bidder and notice of such sale shall be given by the chief of police at least five days before the time listed, therefore by publication once in a newspaper of general circulation published in the community.

SECTION 2. Any provisions of the Torrance City Code or ordinances heretofore inconsistent herewith, to the extent of such inconsistency and insofar as they are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect thirty days after the date of its adoption and prior to the expiration of fifteen days from the passage thereof shall be published at least once in the Torrance Press-Herald, a newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the City of Torrance.
