

## Junior Fire Marshal's Program Earns Awards for Redondo Pupils

Fire Prevention is every one's job — and in Redondo Beach they practice what they preach!

Awards are being made at elementary schools throughout Redondo Beach by the Redondo Beach Fire Department as part of the controlled Junior Fire Marshal's Program, under joint sponsorship of the Redondo Beach Chamber of Commerce and Junior Chamber.

One such award, a colorful and impressive banner was presented at Edison School recently. Participating in the ceremonies conducted by Fire Inspector Paul F. Sul-pice, coordinator of the Junior Fire Marshal's Program were Chamber President Lynn A. Frantz, Jaycee President Barry Hamilton, Edison Principal Jack Irvin, Edison

Third Grade Teacher Mrs. Patricia Pifer, Redondo Beach's "Woman of the Year" for 1963 and Edison Teacher Mrs. Theresa Hoyme, and Chamber Manager Dick Fitzgerald. Honored in behalf of the entire third grade class was Laurie Simpson, 9, who is Junior Fire Marshal and secretary of the Student Council at Edison School. Mrs. Pifer is in charge of Edison's Junior Fire Marshal Program.

Fire Chief Harold V. Harrison said the project, conducted by the Bureau of Fire Prevention under Captain Ivan D. Hunter, is active in 39 third grade classes in 16 schools. With Redondo Beach City School System cooperation, students are provided with books, pamphlets and home inspection check lists of

typical home fire hazards. They are asked to complete the check-lists, thus alerting their parents to sources of possible fires.

A school receives the "coveted banner" only when the "honor roll" is 100% filled. Inspector Sul-pice said, "This program alerts the children to spot fire hazards at an early age, plus allowing them to derive a great deal of satisfaction in arousing parental awareness of fire safety. Fire Department officials commented that it would be a safer world if all adults took a lesson from the Jun-

ior Fire Marshal's. The kids are serious about this task," Inspector Sul-pice said. "We should be all be!"
