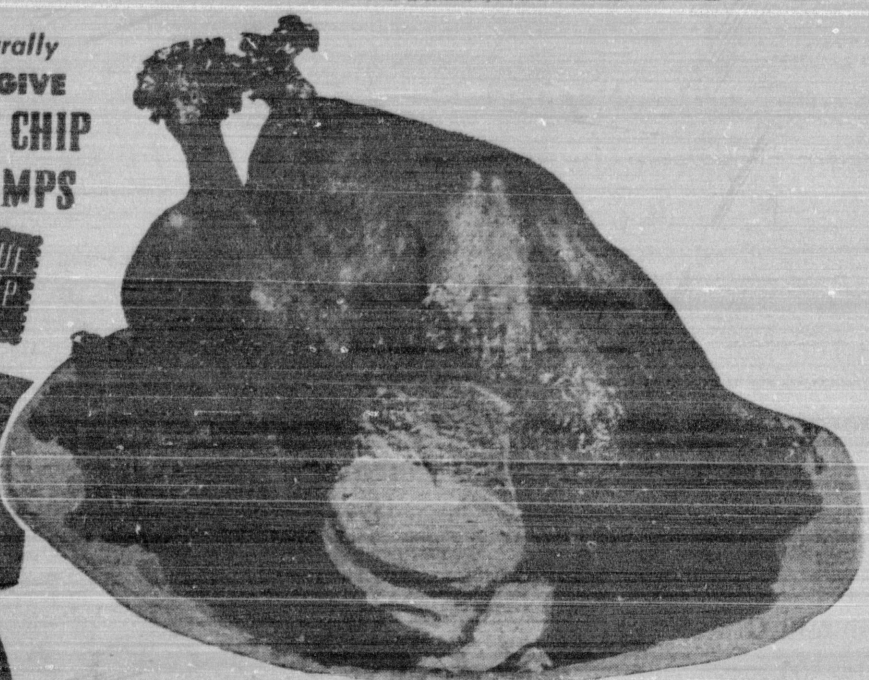

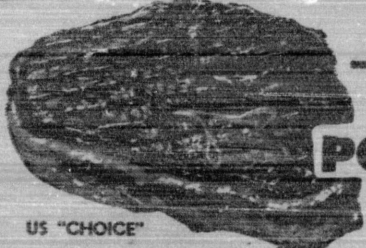

Workers Get Cost of Living Raise

Douglas Aircraft employees have been awarded a one cent per hour pay increase as a result of an increase in the Bureau of Labor Statistics' national cost of living index for December, 1962. The one cent raise increases the annual Douglas payroll by approximately \$603,200 and will affect 14,400 hourly employees at the Douglas Aircraft Group in Long Beach as well as Douglas employees in other parts of the state and nation.
