

## Douglas Aircraft to Hire 3,300 Employees

Employment in the South California divisions of the Douglas Aircraft Group is expected to increase by 3,300 during 1965 to a total of more than 22,500, according to Jackson R. McGowen, group vice president-aircraft for Douglas.

New jobs are being created by expanding activity in the areas of management, engineering, and production.

"WE ARE adding from 150 to 200 new employees per week in a broad range of professional and technical occupations," McGowen said. "Our professional staff, including senior engineers and scientists, will be increased by more than 350 before the year is over."

"Nearly 3,000 will be added to the production force, largely in the category of machine tool operators and other skilled workers."

## Home Has Lead for 11th Year

Home Savings and Loan Assn., Los Angeles, has been named the largest of the nation's 6331 savings and loan companies for the 11th consecutive year by the trade publication American Banker.

Home gained the number one ranking in 1954.

In its yearly accounting of the 300 largest savings firms, American Banker explained combined resources of all the nation's associations amount to \$119.5 billion and that of the 10 largest, six are located in California.

Savings shares throughout the nation reached an all-time high of \$102.7 billion as of Dec. 31, 1964, a gain during the year of \$11.4 billion, or 12.5% per cent.

Home's assets were reported at \$1.827 billion with 356,825 shareholder accounts amounting to \$1,583,842. The second largest association has assets of \$1,173 billion and share accounts of \$932 million.

## Carson Area Funds Voted

Allocation of \$9,000 for street improvements in the Carson Area has been approved by the Board of Supervisors.

The funds have been earmarked for use on Carson and Perry streets and along Avalon Boulevard near 228th Street.
