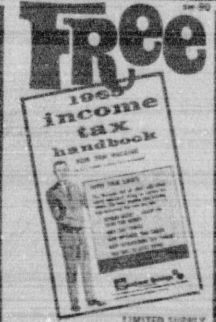
Medical Meeting Planned

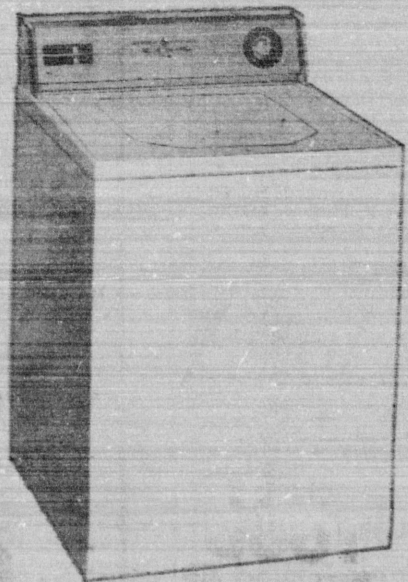

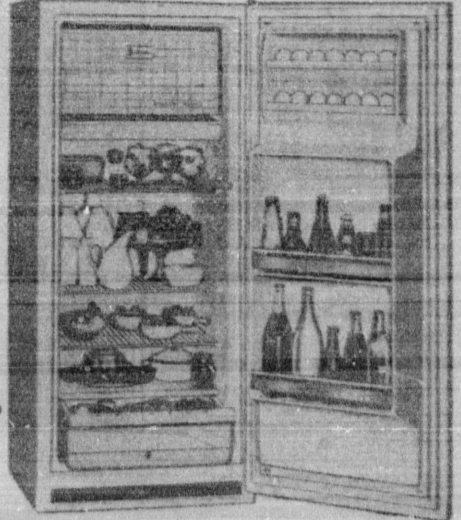

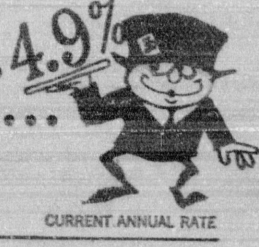
