Seat Belts Tested for School Bus

Installation of seat belts on all school buses is the subject of research being conducted by Los Angeles County in cooperation with the UCLA Institute of Transportation and Traffic Engineering, the County Superintendent of Schools, and the Crown Coach Co.

The bus firm has agreed to donate an old school bus for actual tests by the UCLA institute. Cameras and impact equipment will be installed in the bus which will be subjected to actual crash tests on the breaking system, tire blowouts, and other mechanical failures.

"Seat belts have proven their safety on automobiles and the United States Army requires seat belts on its buses," said Supervisor Kenneth Hahn, who sparked the research program to protect school children.
