

Girl Scouts to Organize New Los Angeles Council

The Girl Scouts of Greater Los Angeles and neighboring cities will soon have a new streamlined organization to serve them.

Mrs. Kenneth A. Manska, organization committee chairman, announced the names of the 10 people selected by the nominating committee as a slate of officers of the newly forming Angeles Girl Scout Council. These persons, plus a board of directors and nominating committee, will be presented for election at the organization meeting on March 12 at the International Hotel. Heading the list is Mrs. R. H. Redmond of Santa Monica for president, Mrs. Merwin Meyers of Los An-

gels for first vice-president and Mrs. Kenneth A. Manska of Inglewood for second vice-president.

District vice presidents will be the link between the local neighborhoods and Council. Nominees and the districts they will serve are: Mmes. Ralph McKee, District I which includes Santa Monica, Pacific Palisades and Malibu; Alfred Finestone, District II which includes West Los Angeles, Beverly Hills, Los Angeles, and Eagle Rock; William Ebinger, District III which includes Culver City, Southwest Los Angeles, Downey, Huntington Park and South Gate; Darrell F. Googe, District IV which includes

Playa del Rey, Westchester, Inglewood, Hawthorne, and El Segundo; and Robert Turner, District V which includes Gardena, Torrance, and San Pedro.

NOMINEES for secretary and treasurer respectively are Mrs. James Roberts of Santa Monica and Mr. Harold Rice of Los Angeles.

These people were selected on the basis of qualifications for membership and ability to perform the job, to provide continuity of leadership, and to include personnel from each District, reflecting the social, religious, educational, economic and civil points of view of the entire Council.

The total membership of 25,000 girls in the new Angeles Girl Scout Council is comprised of approximately 5,000 girls from each District.

The Council's aim is to give better service and to further extend the membership.

MRS. MANSKA stated, "This tremendous undertaking was decided on so that each and every Girl Scout included in this Council will personally gain in educational, camping, and service opportunities."

Branch Board to Visit Red Cross Blood Center

Interested persons are invited to join the Torrance-Lomita Red Cross Branch board of directors Thursday night for their tour of the Regional Red Cross Blood Center.

The Blood Center, located at 1130 S. Vermont in Los Angeles, is the largest in the world and serves as headquarters for the blood program in Los Angeles and Orange Counties.

THE LOCAL group will leave from the employment office of National Supply on Border Avenue between 6:45 and 7 p.m. to travel to the Blood Center.

Stanley Heiman, Red Cross chairman here, says the blood center tour will include a

visit to the donor room where volunteers give blood five days a week from 8:30 a.m. to 8 p.m.

From there, the tour group will visit the laboratory where blood, collected in the building as well as at the five bloodmobiles scheduled throughout the two-county area each day, is processed.

LABORATORY chief will explain how whole blood is stored until delivered to the hospitals for use by the ill and injured. He will also tell the group about the derivatives made from blood.

New Rules for Heavy Vehicles Now Active

Some 16,000 motor carriers who use the public highways as a place of business for their 200,000 big trucks, truck tractors, trailers and semitrailers, and buses will begin answering to the California Highway Patrol with respect to the safety of their vehicles. Legislation enacted in 1963 (for-hire motor carriers operating approximately 50,000 vehicles) were under governmental supervision, originally by the State Public Utilities Commission and since September, 1963, by the California Highway Patrol.

THE RULES and regulations under which the motor carriers will operate were developed, in accordance with legislative direction, jointly by the patrol and an advisory committee composed of representatives of motor carriers and organized labor." CHP Commissioner Bradford M. Crittenden said today.

Crittenden added that a staff of 49 non-uniformed motor carrier operations specialists will inspect vehicles and examine records at motor carriers' terminal locations and maintenance facilities to assure compliance with the law and regulations.
