City Chamber of Commerce Files Accreditation Report

The Torrance Chamber of Commerce has applied for accreditation by the United States Chamber of Commerce. George M. Ebert, chamber director, serves as chairman of the special accreditation committee which directed preparation of the report which has been filed with the national chamber.

The national chamber has set a standard and incentives intended to increase the effectiveness of local chambers. Under Ebert's direction, the Torrance chamber has completed a comprehensive self-analysis of the organization's operations, structure, program of work, objectives and procedures.

A written report has been forwarded to the U. S. Chamber which in turn will assign a representative to come to Torrance to review the report, visit with local leaders and discuss additional phases of the accreditation program.

"The Torrance chamber could be among the first in California to receive the coveted Accredited Award," Ebert said. "The complete, thorough self-analysis and appraisal of our organization will certainly be most helpful. It has shown the board of directors our strong as well as our weaker points and has given excellent guide lines for improving the chamber's operation and program of work."

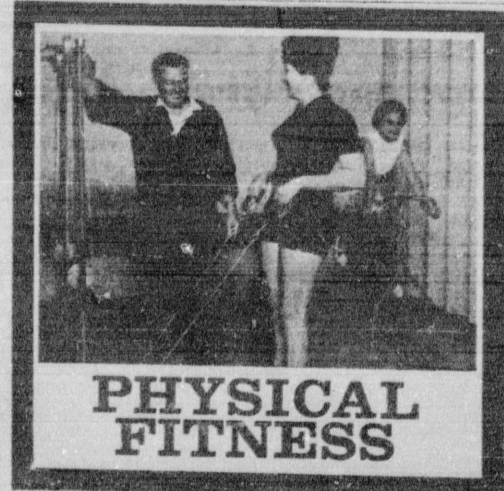
