CURATOR TO SPEAK

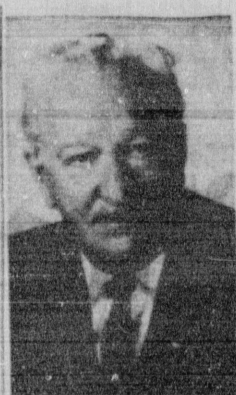
