All Candidates Accept League Speaking Bids

All Torrance School Board candidates have accepted invitations to speak at a public meeting, sponsored by the Torrance League of Women Voters, April 7 at 8 p.m. at the Torrance Recreation Center, 3341 Torrance Blvd. Fourteen candidates will vie for the three Board vacancies to be filled at the April 20 election.

Candidates will be allowed equal time for statement of their positions on issues, according to Mrs. Irwin Boxer, League Voters Service chairman. This will be followed by a question and answer period. Mrs. Lloyd Money will serve as moderator.

Replies to League questionnaires sent to all candidates for the Torrance Board, as the ward 5 position on El Camino College's Board, will be distributed at the meeting. In addition to biographical information on the candidates, the questionnaires ask for each candidate's views on educational programs and for their recommendations and proposals.

"Replies to League questionnaires are printed in the candidates' own words and are edited only to meet the limitations of space," according to Mrs. Boxer. She pointed out that the League of Women Voters is a non-partisan organization and does not take a position on candidates.

Replies to the questionnaires will also be available to the public at all Torrance libraries and various business establishments.

Carnegie Junior High Boundaries Announced

Attendance boundaries for the \$3.3 million Andrew Carnegie Junior High School which will open its doors in September have been announced by Superintendent of Schools Jack P. Crowther. The new school plant is located at 21829 Bonita St. Torrance.

It will open with an estimated enrollment of 1503 students, providing relief for

Wilmington, White and Peary Junior High Schools.

The attendance area for the new school is bounded by the Los Angeles School District boundary on the north and east, the north line of the Scottsdale Condominium and the extension of that line on the south, and an irregular line on the east which roughly parallels Grace Avenue and its extension.

Crown Construction Co. is building the new plant which will be located on a 21-acre site bounded on the north by Carson Street, on the east by Foley Avenue, on the south by 220th Street and on the west by Bonita Street.

When completed, the new junior high will include 22 general classrooms, 26 special classrooms for agriculture, art, business education,

homemaking, music, science, and six shops for industrial arts.

Also on the campus will be a combination boys-girls gymnasium, administrative center, attendance office, health unit, library, combination cafeteria community hall, utility building locker facilities for 2200 students, offstreet parking for 400 bicycles and 100 automobiles.

Cost of installing a traffic control signal at Hawthorne Boulevard and Silver Spur Road will be shared by Los Angeles County and the City of Rolling Hills Estates, according to Supervisor Chairman Burton W. Chace. The project will cost an estimated \$8,000.

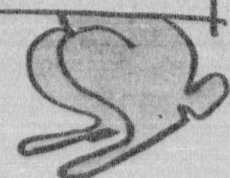
