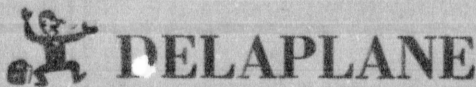


Around the World With



"Are there any camping sites in Mexico for a six-week auto trip via Mexico City, Oaxaca and Yucatan? And would it be safe?"

I've never seen any formal camp sites anywhere in Mexico. But most of Mexico is unfenced. And the beaches are deserted and open. You could probably camp in many more places than in the U.S. Main problem, I think, would be carrying enough bottled water.

As to safety, I would be cautious enough to camp close to tourist centers. Along the tourist route, Mexico is accustomed to you. But you can go off the highway and find very primitive people — speaking Indian dialects instead of Spanish. Sometimes tourists are disturbing to them.

"We are sailing on the SS Orleana with stops in the West Indies enroute Europe. The question is whether to buy a camera here or on the way."

For a small American camera, buy it here. If you are going into one of the luxury foreign cameras, buy at one of the West Indies free ports — like Nassau. About half price since it is duty-free.

"What is the appropriate clothing in Tahiti?"

Most informal, day and night. Most comfortable find is very lightweight, washable khaki pants, aloha shirt and go-ahead slippers. For women, shorts, washable cotton, mums. Forget ties, jackets, cocktail dresses.

"We will be in Panama City for three or four days. We don't know what to do but the tour seems to have set up a 'slumming' night club tour."

They set up that "slumming" tour because there isn't anything else. As long as I can remember, Panama City

and Colon have been sailors' towns. The night clubs are pretty sad. But, since they set it up, go. What else can you do?

There's an interesting light plane ride out to the San Blas Islands to see the Indians and trade for shells and such. You contact a man named "Jungle Jim" — try the lobby of the Panama Hilton.

"What do you think is the best way to plan a summer driving and sightseeing trip in the U.S. with children?"

The big gasoline companies are most anxious to help you do this. And a number of them will plan your route. Points of interest and everything you want. (You tell them where you want to go, of course.) I know you can pick up the application forms at Standard Oil and Chevron stations. It's all free so try it.

"I would like to buy a guitar while in Spain. Do you know the best brand? And how about shipping it home?"

The best guitars in Mexico are labeled "Valencia type." So maybe the best guitars are from Valencia, Spain. However, do this: Call up the American Visitors' Bureau in Madrid. Same building as the TWA office on the Gran Via. That's a shopping service and they also ship. They'll know.

"We would like to rent a car and drive up to Dublin as we have three days until our plane leaves."

Then you don't want the direct route — it's only three hours or so. And not a pretty interesting road. Drive north along the coast to Galway. One leisurely day. Next day drive across Ireland to Dublin, another leisurely day. Both are colorful drives. Green country. White sheep. Gray, ruined castles. And you

should see some "fairy rings" enroute.

At Shannon airport, you should find a rather thick paper-back book on Ireland. Tells you the legends and history of all the towns you pass through. Have your airline have a car rented and ready. The car hire agencies run short during the season.

"Should we have a small amount of English money when we land in London?"

It's handy. If it's daytime and not a weekend when you land, there are banks open at London airport. If they aren't going to be open, you can buy English pounds at the American airport bank. Helps with taxis and tipping.
