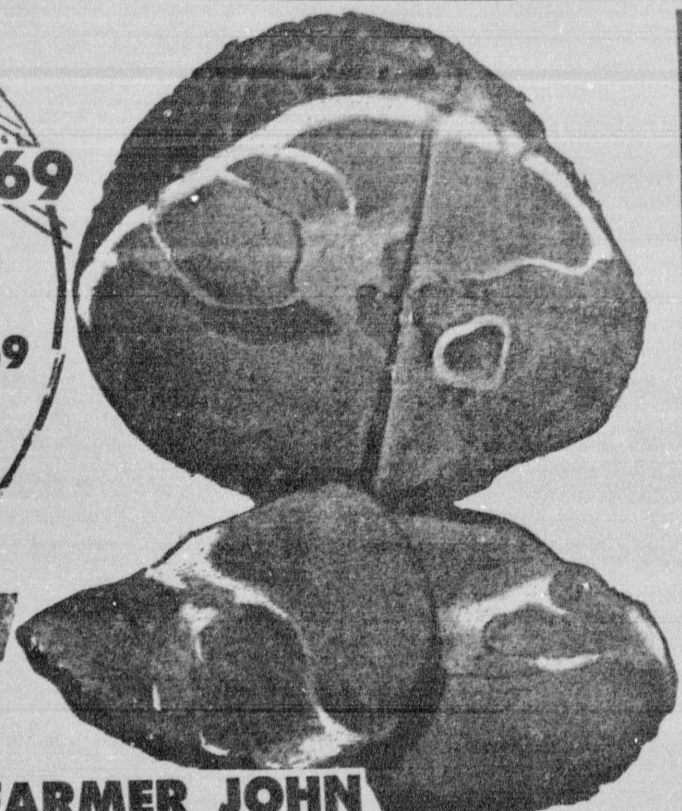

Catholics, Jews Plan Conference

More than 250 religious and lay leaders are expected to participate in a conference to bring Catholics and Jews deeper understanding on issues of mutual concern May 23, 2 p.m. to 9 p.m. on the campus of Marymount College in Palos Verdes.

Titled "Neighbors — Yet Strangers," the joint venture is the first of its kind in Southern California. Topics to be discussed include common interests and goals, and such blocks to understanding each other as stereotypes and the roots of prejudice, according to David P. Goldman, president of the Pacific Southwest Regional Advisory Board of the Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith.

Mrs. Henry Monsky, former vice president of ADL's regional board and a recent national president of the Federation of Temple Sisterhoods, will serve with Walter O'Keefe, noted entertainment figure, as cochairman of the conference. Consultants are Sister Bernard Marie of Marymount College and Mrs. Charles Blumenberg, educational and program consultant for the Pacific Southwest Regional Office of the League.
