RB Sets Sunrise Service

Annual Easter Sunrise Services will be held at the bandshell in Redondo Beach City Park from 6 to 7 a.m. Sunday, according to Lynne A. Frantz, president of the sponsoring Redondo Beach Chamber of Commerce. The public is invited.

Guest speaker at the non-denominational service will be The Rev. Charles Corwin. In charge of the program will be Dr. Alfred K. Corwin, chairman of the chamber's Religious Activities Committee. Dr. Corwin, a Redondo Beach optician, is the brother of the guest speaker.

Redondo Union High School's Madrigal and AcaPELLa Choir will present four numbers, highlighted by a solo by soprano Vivien Snyder. Directed by Thomas Wilson, the group sang at similar services at Hollywood Bowl in 1963 and Redondo in 1964.

THE REV. CORWIN was reared in Manhattan Beach and attended Redondo Union High School 1939-41. He became interested in church work through membership in the Fisherman's Club, 704 Strand Avenue, Manhattan Beach—a boys' club which has been reaching high school students with the Christian message and challenging them to Christian service.

He obtained his BD at Fuller Theological Seminary in 1951, and is currently enrolled in a doctoral program of study in Japanese linguistics at both Claremont College Graduate School and UCLA Graduate School.

IN THE MISSIONARY field Mr. Corwin served in 1952-56 in rural Japan, establishing evangelical churches in Ise-sake, Homjo, and Sakai in the Kanto plain above Central Japan. From 1957 to 1964, he established a student center at Waseda University in Tokyo, a training center at Hoya and a recreation center at Naguri. During both Japanese tours of duty he was assigned to the Tokyo Evangelistic Center.

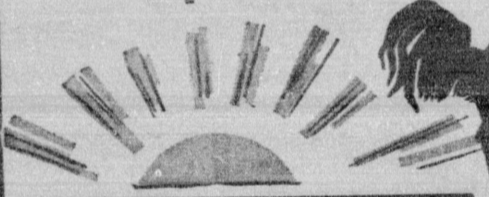
Good Friday will be celebrated by the Rev. Frank E. Richelieu at 2 p.m. His topic will be "The New Covenant."
