

High Defense Executive To Lead Torrance Parade

Charles J. Hitch, assistant secretary of defense, has accepted an invitation to officiate as grand marshal for the sixth annual Torrance Armed Forces Day Parade. The parade will move along Torrance Boulevard Saturday, May 15, climaxing a celebration which is scheduled to begin Friday, May 14. Prior to his appointment

as assistant secretary of defense, Hitch was with the Rand Corp. of Santa Monica. He joined the Rand Corp. in 1948, and most recently served as chairman of its research council.

A graduate of the University of Arizona, Hitch completed one year of graduate work at Harvard University. He earned a Rhodes scholarship and received his master's degree at Oxford, where he was elected a Fellow of Queens College in 1935.

During World War II, he served on the first lend-lease mission to London and then on the War Production Board. Later in the U.S. Army, he was commissioned a first lieutenant.

Hitch is expected to arrive in the area Thursday, May 13, with his wife. He will attend a San Fernando Ameri-

Miller suggested that some procedure might be established where residents of a given area could be heard before a permit for pigeons would be granted. "The easy way out is to say

"No," Miller said, "but we are going to take rights away from these people."

Opponents will get a second chance to be heard when the pigeon ordinance is before the council May 4 for its final reading.

IN OTHER action, the council:

- Awarded a contract for demolition of buildings in the downtown parking areas to Duane Rash of West Covina. Work on the \$2,865 contract will begin May 1, with the parking lots expected to be ready July 1.

Basic requirements include a happy marriage, a love of children, and the ability to give a foster child a good home, says Supervisor Burton W. Chace.

Steps in the adoption procedure are not difficult, and children often are placed in less than five months.
