YOU'LL HAVE to watch your conversation in front of the set. When your wife comes in and says, "Good night, honey," the television turns off. Or if your wife tells you to shut up (which is more likely than "Good night, honey") the television may obey before she does. The possibilities are endless. The dangers are everywhere. "Scientists at our Princeton laboratories have obtained a patent for a syllable analyzer that takes spoken words apart and compresses them into electronic code." continued W. Walter Watts, the RCA spokesman, execu-YOU'LL HAVE to watch

THAT'S ABOUT right for THAT'S ABOUT right for the average American home dialogue when the television set is on, I would guess — probably too many. With conversation rapidly becoming a lost art all over the land, there will soon be no need for anything but the most basic words anyway, starting with the following vocabulary for viewing: viewing

Lousy With the addition of a few prepositions, and in better-educated circles, adjectives, the whole spectrum of human communication while viewing television can be readily un-derstood. University of Cali-fornia students and movie stars like Eva Marie Saint can get along with even shorter words.

I THINK IT'S just dandy that RCA sets will soon be able to obey our orders. What I'm worried about is this:

"In 10 to 20 years the television picture tube should give way to a thin screen, one or two inches thick, and large enough to cover a living room wall or small enough to fit into a pocket," concluded RCA.
