## Man, Woman of Year To Get Cash Awards

Selection of California's Junior College Man and Woman of the Year will be-gin next September with the first two winners being named in the spring of 1966.

Announcement of the state-wide recognition for out-

standing junior college students was made by Dr. Fred-erick Huber during the spring conference of the Cal-ifornia Junior College Asso-

ifornia Junior College Asso-ciation in Los Angeles.
Dr. Huber, president of
Palomar College and chair-man of the association's
Committee on Cooperative Projects with Industry, said that the man and woman se-lected as "California's Junior College Man and Woman of the Year" would each re-ceive a \$1,000 cash award from Bank of America.

"ALL OF THE state's junior colleges affiliated with the California Junior College Association will be represented in the competition. Con-tenders for the award will be selected primarily on the masis of scholarship, community service and college activities," Dr. Huber said.

Each junior college will se-lect two candidates, who will compete in one of eight re-gional contests held early

gional contests held early each year.

The 16 finalists will com-pete for the top awards on the last day of the Annual Spring Conference of the California Junior College As-sociation.

Winners will be named at the closing banquet of the conference.

AT REGIONAL and final

events the students will appear before civic, communi-ty, business and industrial leaders who will act as judges.

Dr. Huber said that in addition to the two \$1,000 awards for the winners the Bank of America, which sponsors the competition, will present certificates to each junior college winner and trophies to the regional winners. The bank will also host contestants, judges, fac-ulty representatives and guests at luncheons where each of the eight regional winners will be announced.


A committee of California Junior College Association representatives and bank officials is now working on the program and will announce complete details early this fall.
