Janice Cohn and Jim Arguello have been installed as queen and king of North High School's service club, the Julians and Valiants.

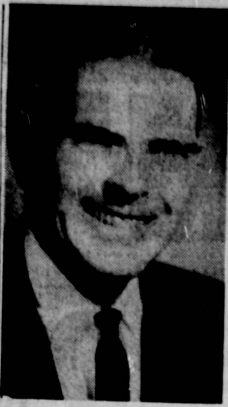
Miss Cohn is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Cohn of 3925 W. 185th St.
