## Work Started on School For Hawthorne Christian

Ground breaking was held this week, and construction is under way for the new Hawthorne Christian School, located in the center of Palo del Amo Woods, according to developer Ray Watt.

The new 10-classroom facility, serving kindergarten through eighth grades, will open in September to meet the educational needs of an estimated 400 pupils. Its location in Palo del Amo Woods is just west of the Harbor Freeway and south of Sepulveda Boulevard.

Of contemporary design and construction, the new school has a faculty of 15. Mrs. Syble Wilkinson, a teacher/administrator with more than 20 years experience, will be principal of the new school, Watt said.

A SPECIAL feature is a child care center being provided for the enrollees on the campus of the Hawthorne Christian School. Working parents may leave children there between 6:30 a.m. and 6:30 p.m.

The Rev. Carl Pike founded the chain of five Hawthorne Christian Schools 23 years ago. Coinciding with the opening of the new school in Palo del Amo Woods a mobile science unit will be put into use. Displays by the nation's outstanding science-oriented manufacturers will be taken directly to the schools in this auxiliary classroom.
