## Douglas Begins **Navy Contracts**

Two fixed price letter con- Douglas A-4E and TA-4E Sky-tracts totaling \$3,193,893 for hawks.

tracts totaling \$3,193,393 for production of aircraft bomb racks and adapters have been awarded by the U. S. Navy to the Douglas Aircraft Division.

Under the contracts, a total of 1,809 assemblies will be manufactured on the bomb rack production line at the Douglas facility here.

First of the two contracts calls for production of 1,172 bomb racks and adapters at a fixed price of \$2,073,287; the second specified 637 bomb release racks at \$1,120 506.

Three bomb rack designs are currently in production at the Torrance plant, All are adaptable to a variety of combat aircraft, including the
