# Immunization, X-Ray Clinics Set Tomorrow

The Torrance Health Center, 2300 W. Carson St., will hold two special evening clinics tomorrow, according to Earl W. Kendrick, M.D., Torrance District Health Officer. Both an immunization clinic and a chest X-ray survey will be held from 6 to 8 p.m.

Immunizations against polio, diphtheria, tetanus, whooping cough and smallpox will be given. "The time to get protected against these serious diseases is now—before an epidemic threatens," Dr. Kendrick warned. All parents are urged to keep a record of each child's immunizations in order to know which diseases he is protected against and the time for boosters.

Dr. Kendrick reminded all adults that an annual chest X-ray is recommended for every adult and is especially important for those over the

age of 40. "Tuberculosis control effort for many years has been directed towards early detection of cases so that treatment may begin at a stage when the disease is most 'curable,'" explained Dr. Kendrick.

"The Los Angeles County Health Department hopes that the evening clinics for immunizations and chest X-rays will bring in those persons who, because of work or lack of transportation, find it difficult to attend the day clinics or go to private physicians," concluded Dr. Kendrick.


