## Road Work Aid Slated By County Vital highway improvements in the Southwest area cities are included in the county's nearly \$27 million aid-to-cities highway budget, Supervisor Charman Burton W. Chace has announced. As chairman of the Supervisors' Road Committee, Chace said the county appro-priation is 14 per cent above last year's expenditure for the area. A major portion of the amount earmarked for the Southwest area as the county somes in the form of highway aid made available to the 76 cities within the county. Supervisor Chace pointed out that Los Angeles County is one of the few in the state to grant financial aid to its incorporated population. "This type of cooperation," he continued, "makes possible continuous development of needed highway projects across jurisdictional boundaries to add continuity and efficiency to our highway sysefficiency to our highway sys-Major projects included in the budget are: 223rd Street (Normandie to 223rd Street (Normandie to Alameda) \$1,084,000; Lomita (Normandie to Alameda) \$969,00; Pier Avenue (Artesia to Coast Highway) \$483,000; and La Cienega (Stocker to City boundary) \$300,000, Chace said.
