IT WAS FELT that to focus IT WAS FELT that to focus on issues and problems, ra-ther than on bills and resolu-tions, could be the first step toward development of omni-bus legislation in the various fields. It is hoped that the system will encourage the committees to come up with full solutions to major prob-lems, and to draft committee legislation incorporating such legislation incorporating such solutions. The procedure could help to reduce the number of bills drastically, thus freeing the full Assembly for more thorough consideration of major policy issues.




