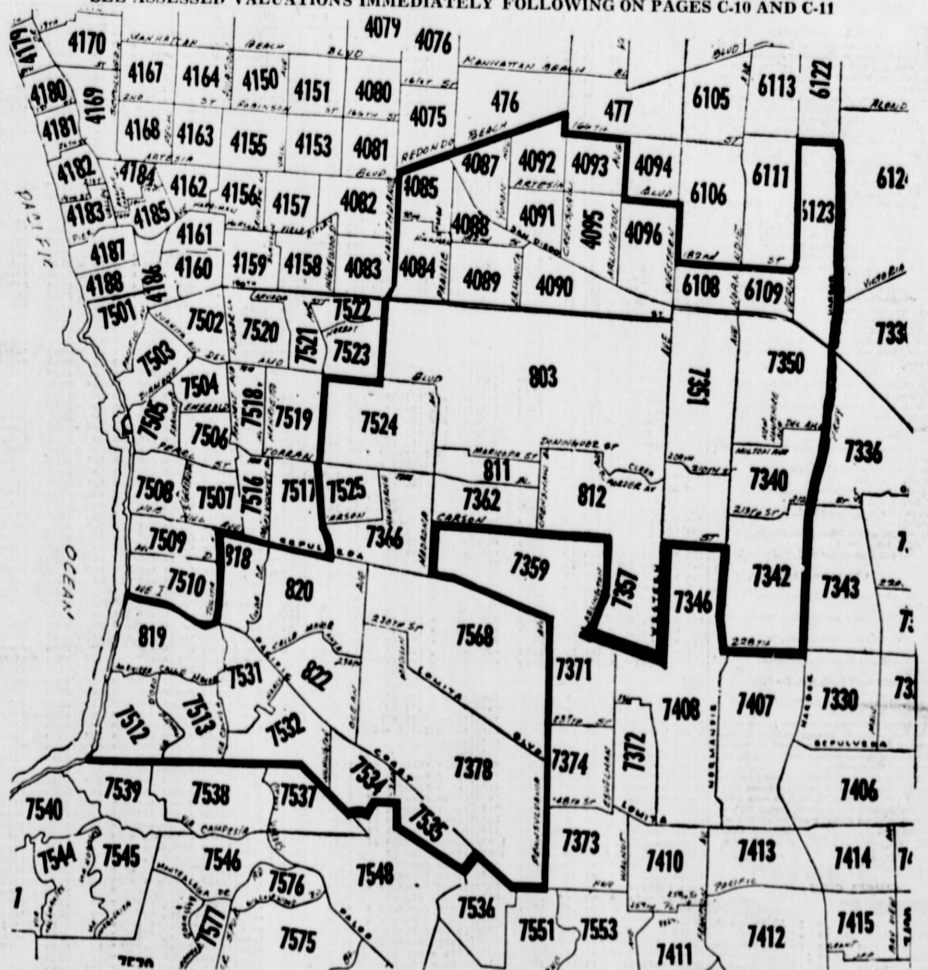

BIRTHS Data Service Offered To Southwest Realtors

A computerized real estate information service is being offered to Torrance realty firms and savings and loan associations by a newly formed Torrance business.

Smith's Electro Data Service, to be known as SEDS, is located at 3303 W. Sepulveda Blvd. The firm selects properties from the vast Southwest area and fits them to needs of customers "with speed, flexibility, and accuracy," according to owner Barrett C. Smith.

The firm files the multiple listings on a computer and selects the desired listings on request by pushing a few buttons.

"REALTORS may telephone the data service and receive the listings they want," Smith says. The service is available only to members of realty boards.

"Using the standard photo listing," Smith said, "the salesman is constantly presented with hours of search to find the proper house for his buyer."

"HE ALSO must purge daily the files of sales, expirations, renewals, price reductions, memos, and many other necessary bulletin items.
