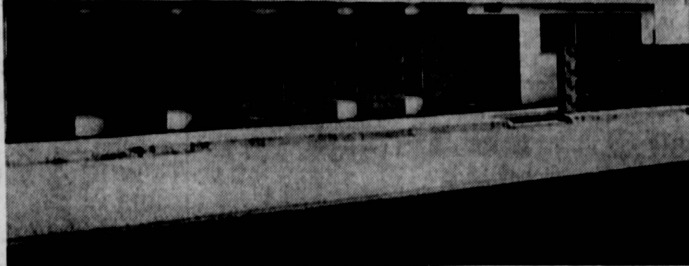
Record High Enrollment Anticipated
