Virtue Is Non-Partisan, And So Is Vice, He Says

By CHARLES E. CHAPEL Assemblyman, 46th District In accordance with the State Constitution, there are 40 State Senators and 80 members of the Assembly, often referred to as Assem-blymen, although one mem-

ber of the Assembly is a lady, Mrs. Pauline L. Davis. At the beginning of 1965, there were 16 senators who listed their occupation as "attorney." One senator, Stanley Arnold, became a judge by appointment, leav-ing 15 who are still in the Senate Senate.

For some strange reason. For some strange reason, California is the only state where lawyers usually give their occupation as "attor-ney," which is an incom-plete designation of occupa-tion, because the word "at-torney" standing by itself means an agent. For exam-ple, attorney-in-fact is a fan-

This report on the preponderance of lawyers in the California Legislature is timely because the Assem-bly Constitutional Amendbly Constitutional Amend-ment, which passed from the Assembly to the Senate with only one dissenting vote, and contains provis-ions for two regular sessions and a pay raise for all leg-islators also contains pro-visions to protect the pub islators also contains pro-visions to protect the pub-lie against lawyers in the Legislature having what is politely called "a conflict of interest." This was written into the proposed amend-ment to our State Constitu-tion by lawyers in the As-sembly, not by those of us who are not lawyers. Here is one example of a conflict of interest: A law-yer who is a member of the Legislature at the same time can legally accept fees from

can legally accept fees from powerful corporations for

giving them legal advice and at the same time vote for or against bills, in committees and on the floor of the Assembly and the Sen-ate, which directly affect
