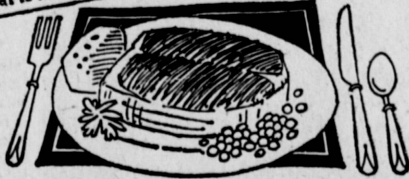

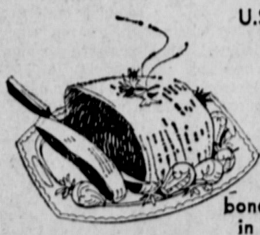

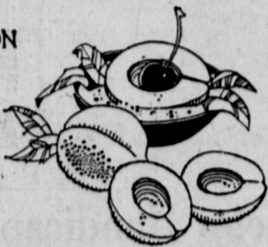

Ner Tamid Will Hold Confirmation Friday

The second confirmation class ceremony of Congregation Ner Tamid of South Bay will be held Friday at 8:30 p.m. at the Pacific Unitarian Church, Montalaga Drive and Basswood Avenue, Palos Verdes Peninsula.

To the Conservative Jew, confirmation of its youngsters is a custom closely tied to the observance of the Shavuot Festival which recalls the giving of the Ten Commandments at Sinai. It is there-

fore fitting that this be the time that Jewish boys and girls, aged approximately 15, are formally confirmed, or initiated, into the fellowship of their faith. Youngsters who have successfully completed their prescribed course of study are confirmed and become full-fledged and responsible sons and daughters of the Jewish faith.

Keep Vital Papers Near, VA Suggests

Keep family documents such as birth and marriage certificates where they can be readily found, Mort Webster, manager of VA's Southern California Regional Office, advised veterans and their dependents today.

Webster said documents of this sort may be needed to support claims for veterans benefits and for other purposes.

These include military discharges or separation papers, death certificates, divorce decrees and guardianship or child custody evidence, he said.

Veterans claims which may require these documents include disability or death compensation or pension and burial benefits.
