

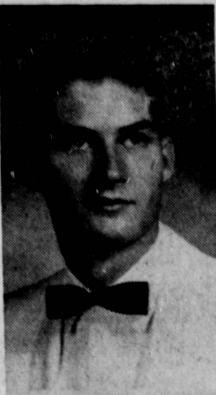
## Student Wins Annapolis Appointment

A presentation depicting caricatures of different types of ants and their habits was presented by Den 5 and the closing ceremony was under the direction of Den 1.

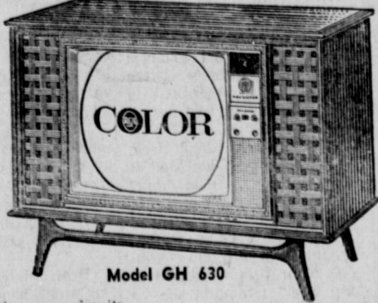
