

Gas Company Investments Are Heading Underground

Expansion and improvement plans included in the gas company's \$27 million 1966 budget will benefit residents of Torrance both directly and indirectly. Direct benefits will come from items specifically included in a \$1,100,000 budget for the company's Southwest division which serves the Torrance area, according to division manager S. W. Lynch.

"In continuing our program of expansion to match pace with the growing natural gas needs of all the people in this division," Lynch stated, "the 1966 budget reflects our determination to provide the finest service to our customers along with the finest fuel now available to the public—natural gas."

According to Lynch, the expected growth in the division will require about 64,000 ft. of new gas mains at a cost of \$200,000. An additional allotment of \$430,000 will be necessary for new business.

"Although much of this investment will be buried underground," he continued, "the economic impact of this new business budget is obvious and reflects our company's faith in the future of continued growth in the communities we serve."

Betterments and replacements to the division's distribution system call for an outlay of \$450,000. Balance of the division budget will be used in construction and remodeling of buildings, purchase and replacement of equipment, tools and furniture.

Indirect benefits will be received from the gas company's purchase of additional supplies of out-of-state gas, additions to the overall network of pipelines feeding natural gas into Southern California and addition of related facilities that will insure a constant and ready supply of the Southland's most desired fuel.
