## Menveg Backers Claim He Holds Demo Lead for 32nd

As the race for the first state senator from the new 32nd district goes into the home stretch, Lloyd A. Menveg appears to be taking the lead for the Democratic nomination with wide support from labor, business, and Democratic leaders, his campaign directors claimed this morning.

Main plank in Menveg's platform is a reduction in local property taxes by new legislation for uniform statewide assessment ratios, a property tax ceiling of 1½ per cent of market value, and correction of formulas for distribution of state tax funds for school support and free-ways, which have long been discriminatory against Southern California.

H. E. "Bud" Riddings, vice president of the Long Beach Harbor Commission, is actively supporting Menveg's candidacy. Los Angeles City Councilman John S. Gibson, Jr. and Mrs. Charles J. Colden Sr., widow of the former Congressman from this area, both of San Pedro, are serving as honorary co-chairmen of the Menveg for Senate Committee.

## Joseph Bruno Seeks Democratic Support

Joseph C. Bruno, who calls himself a "new breed Democrat," and "the thinking man's Democrat," is among those seeking nomination on the Democratic ticket next Tuesday in the 32nd Senate District.

Bruno, who lives at 1227 W. 245th St. in Harbor City, is a former professional musician now teaching in Los Angeles secondary schools.

He was graduated from California State College at Los Angeles in the top ten of a class of more than 1,200 and has attended New York University, UCLA, and the Los Angeles Conservatory of Music.

Before joining the Los Angeles district nine years ago, he taught music for five years at the Westlake College.

Many of his students in jazz composition and music arranging now are well known in the music and recording industry.

In the late 1940s, he led his own recording band under the professional name of Jerry Brent.

An active member of three unions at present, Bruno boasts a total union membership of 76 years, including American Federation of Teachers, American Federation of Musicians; Local 353, Long Beach Musicians; Local 802, New York City Musicians; and Paper Workers Local 447 of New York, of which he was a charter member.

Bruno has been active in California politics at every level from grass roots to managing a Congressional candidate's campaign. He currently is co-chairman of the California Citizens' Committee for Honest Government.

Bruno and his wife, Lee, have two children, a daughter, Darylle, a junior in college, and a son, Randy, a junior at Narbonne High School.

Since the program's inception ten years ago, only 987 educational secretaries from 39 states have earned such awards.

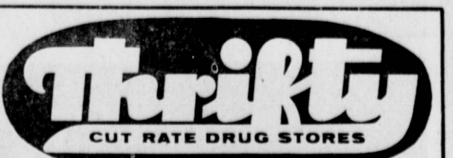
