

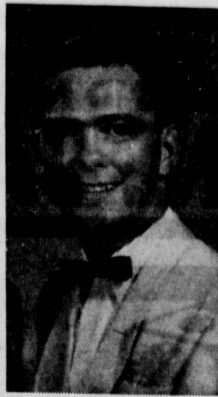
Thomas Hall Receives King Bachelor of Arts

American Legion Urges Yes on Proposition A

A resolution urging a "yes" vote on Proposition A as the answer to the "desperate need" for a Watts-Willowbrook hospital has been adopted by the 23rd District of the American Legion.

Supervisor Kenneth Hahn, honorary chairman of the Citizens' Committee for Proposition A on the June 7 primary ballot, said today he had been notified of the action by Al B. Ferrer, adjutant of the Legion district.

"There is a desperate need for a general hospital in the southeast Los Angeles area," the resolution noted, "and the American Legion has always been in the forefront in supporting adequate hospitaliza-

tion as a community service." THE RESOLUTION also pointed out that the proposed hospital will relieve overcrowding at the Los Angeles County General Hospital, Harbor General, Rancho Los Amigos and other county facilities.

Hahn said many other veterans' organization have taken similar action in support of Proposition A.

Serving as chairman of the Citizens' Committee for Proposition A is John A. McCone, former head of the CIA and chairman of the Governor's Commission which investigated the Watts riot last summer.

"FUNDS RAISED in the Hope Sunday solicitation are vital to the pilot Medical Center's continuing services to the men, women and children of this community," Lynn emphasized, and added that this year the City of Hope has embarked on a \$10,000,000 "New Horizons" expansion program to better serve the needs of those who seek its help. "This is in addition," he said, "to its annual operating budget of \$9,000,000 plus."
