

Summer School Classes Set for 14,000 Students

Preliminary estimates indicate that more than 14,000 Torrance students will attend summer school, according to Dr. Lloyd Jones, curriculum consultant.

The six-week session will take place from June 20 through July 29. Classes will be offered at all elementary and high schools in the district. Students may register up to and including the first day of school.

Offered as a continuation of the regular year-round program, summer school will emphasize the academics. Academically talented seventh-graders and all graduating eighth-graders will be given the opportunity to take two high school courses from a selection of 28 offerings. High school students will have 170 courses to choose from.

Elementary classes will offer students a chance to study the regular courses more fully. Top students will be able to delve deeper into various subjects, while slower students may get help in subjects in which they need it, Jones said.

Enrollment is limited to students who live in Torrance. This includes students who attend private or parochial schools during the regular year.

New Victoria Park Golf Course May Be Ready Early Next Month

Supervisor Kenneth Hahn announced this week that the new Victoria Park Golf Course at 192nd and Avalon is set for completion in November, 1966, to provide additional recreational facilities for the people of Los Angeles County.

Hahn pointed out that the clubhouse should be completed by July 1.

Several factors have contributed to delaying the opening of the course and clubhouse. These included rain and muddy site conditions and a strike of equipment operators.

The Victoria Park course is being financed at no cost to the taxpayers by the County Retirement Board.

GREEN FEES paid by golfers for the use of the course will pay back the Retirement Board's investment within a few years.

This method of financing, Hahn said, “not only meets the recreational needs of the community and preserves open areas in this growing metropolis, but makes sure the golfers who use the course pay for them.”

Hahn began this program of financing in 1953 with the Western Avenue Golf Course at 120th and Western. Originally set for subdivision by its private owners, Hahn secured Retirement Board financing and the project was so successful that it has paid back the investment and full ownership has been transferred to the County.

SUPERVISOR Hahn said adequate recreational space must be set aside in growing Los Angeles County to provide for the future. He cited a constant trend in new housing tracts and subdivisions which leaves less and less open space in this County as years go by.

Located near Gardena, the Victoria Park Golf Course will cover 177 acres which have been virtually idle for seven years.

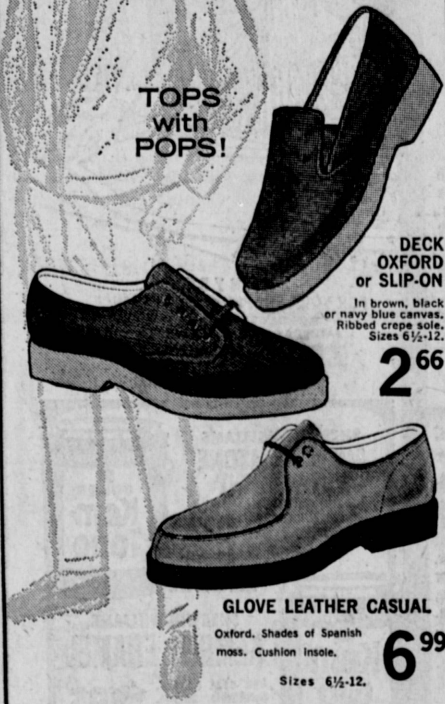

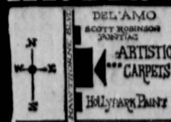

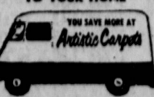
