## Red Cross Pays Tribute to Its Many Volunteers

A delegation of local Red Cross volunteers was among those observing the 50th anniversary of the Los Angeles Red Cross Chapter at the chapter's annual meeting last week in the Coconut Grove, Ambassador Hotel.

Headlining the luncheon celebration were stars of NBC television Lorne Greene, the Pa Cartwright of "Bonanza," and Fred and Micky Finn and their group, whose rinky-tink music is heard on the network on Thursday night.

The chapter's charter was granted by President Woodrow Wilson on Oct. 2, 1916. In the 50 intervening years the chapter has become the third largest in the nation. It covers 2,470 square miles and serves 4,000,000 people.

The services include: assistance to servicemen and their families; disaster relief; blood; education in water safety; first aid; mother and care; home nursing; baby-sitting; a youth activities program, and innumerable opportunities for volunteers to work in hospitals and in connection with blood collection and distribution.

**TO MAKE** Red Cross services more readily available to residents of outlying communities, and to better organize communities in order that they might assume their full share of responsibilities

for the Red Cross programs, 13 branch organizations within the five districts of the Los Angeles Chapter have evolved.

The Red Cross branch serving this community is a complete and autonomous entity complete with its own officers and committee for each Red Cross service, but is coordinated with other branches through liaison with the chapter headquarters in Los Angeles.

The chapter has five district service centers in San Pedro, Inglewood, Westwood, Van Nuys, and South Gate.

Former Torrance branch chairmen who were honored at the meeting were Bob L. Haggard (1948), W. A. Felker (1952), Mayor Albert Isen (1953), Dr. Don C. Moshos (1955-56), Stanley E. Remel-meyer (1957), Dr. Warren H. Low (1958), Henry Halverson Jr. (1959), George Post (1961-62), Mrs. Frank Pagac (1963), and Stanley Heiman (1964-65).

Speaker for the occasion was Ramone S. Eaton, vice president of the American National Red Cross with offices in Washington, D.C., and a vice president of the League of Red Cross Societies, which has headquarters in Geneva, Switzerland.

Fathers will be honored at the 11 a.m. services Sunday at Central Evangelical United Brethren Church, Marcelina at Arlington Avenue.

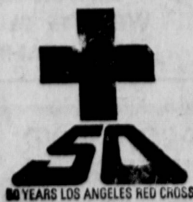
The Rev. Walter M. Stanton, pastor, will conduct the services. Following a tradition in the church, gifts will be presented to the senior and junior fathers at the service.

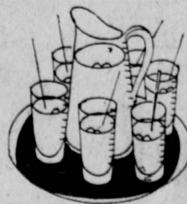

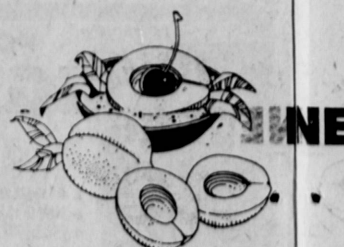
