Fiesta de Flores to Blossom June 17-19

The fourth annual flower show, Fiesta de Flores, will open June 17 at 1 p.m. at South Coast Botanic Gardens, 26701 Rolling Hills Road, Palos Verdes Peninsula.

The three-day show which is sponsored by the Foundation will be open to the public without charge on June 17 from 1 to 7 p.m., on June 18 from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m. and on June 19 from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Amateur entries will include sun and shade plants, cut flowers, floral arrangements, and landscape exhibits. Many of the garden clubs and societies such as the orchid and begonia growers plan entries.

Professional entries will include the same categories as the amateurs and some of the exhibitors will be The Begonia Farm, Rolling Hills Nursery, and Sears. Schools with displays will be UCLA and USC. Garden enthusiasts will find almost every kind of plant family.

THIS YEAR again there will be a plant sale—inexpensive plants at a bargain and exotic ones as well.

At 2 p.m. each day Hamilton Williams, staff member of the Department of Arboreta and Botanic Gardens will speak on "Operation Green carpet."

John Naka, of the Los Angeles Sam Puka Bonsai Club will give a lecture demonstration on the art of Bonsai at 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. Sunday.

Joe Littlefield, garden columnist and plant authority, will be at the gardens each day to answer the questions of home gardeners.

Maps will be available for a self guided tour of the gardens.
