## Home Sets Savings Rate Hike

The highest interest rates paid to savers by a bank or savings and loan in a quarter of a century will be effective July 1 at Home Savings and Loan Association, it was announced Friday by Howard Ahmanson, chairman of the board. Home will pay 5 3/4 per cent on special bonus accounts, and 5 1/4 per cent on passbook accounts.

This move was made, according to Ahmanson on the basis of Home's belief that savings and loans must pay competitive rates if they are to fulfill their basic function of encouraging thrift and home ownership.

Financial authorities generally agree that existing rates will not increase the availability of savings and lending funds. "We are hopeful," declared Ahmanson, that the sound and well managed California savings and loan industry will follow our lead in providing funds for the home-buying public to avert a near-catastrophe in the all-important housing industry and the allied trades that depend upon it. More people are dependent on it than on any other activity."

Recognizing the fact that the housing industry affects hundreds of thousands of people who make their livelihood as carpenters, plumbers, electricians, masons, painters, real-estate agents, and other servicing industries, Home directors believe the increased savings rate will provide a sufficient increase in lendable funds to stabilize interest rates. "This action could help reduce the chances of inflation by encouraging savings," Ahmanson said.

## Church Plans 17 Meetings During Year

A total of 17 conventions will be held by Jehovah's Witnesses during 1966, according to Leonard Olliff, presiding minister of the local congregation. Meetings will be held in the United States, Canada, and the British Isles.

The San Francisco convention, scheduled Aug. 3 to 7, will be attended by approximately 55,000 delegates, with more than 100 representatives from Torrance planning to attend.

Conventions will be held at Dallas, Tex.; Newark, N. J.; Baltimore, Md.; Miami, Fla.; and Mobile, Ala. with more than 300,000 delegates attending.

A 23-year-old nurse was treated at Little Company of Mary Hospital, then released, following a two-car collision about 4 p.m. Friday. The injured girl was identified as Charmaine C. Colin of 389 Palos Verdes Blvd.

Police said the driver of the second car was Fred John DuBois, 69, of 4554 W. 172nd St. The accident occurred at the intersection of 220th Street and Gramercy Avenue. Officers said both vehicles were traveling at "unsafe" speeds as they entered the intersection.
