

## Late Model Stock Cars Compete Sunday Night

Racing fans will get an extra treat over the July 4 holiday weekend when the NAS-CAR Pacific Coast Late Model Stock Cars invade Ascot Park in Gardena Sunday night for a 100-lap double-header program for the ARA Figure 8 stockers.

Stock car racing on the West Coast has gained more prominence the last few years since Les Richter, the ex-Ram linebacker, has begun spearheading the NAS-CAR events at Riverside International Raceway, Hanford Speedway and Ascot Park.

Ascot Park is the only track outside of Riverside where racing enthusiasts can see the new 1966 cars compete and top drivers vie for top prize money (\$3,500) and Pacific

Coast championship points. Sunday night's action will see the "high-rise" Fords and the "Hemi" powered Chrysler products battling again for supremacy of the stock car racing circuit.

Those "pistol-toting" feuds that are usually found down South, like those of the Hatfields and McCoy's, just don't materialize under the quiet Southern California sun and stars.

## Paul Jones on July 4 Card at Ascot

Point leaders Don Thomas of El Cajon, Frank Secrist of Bakersfield, and Paul Jones of Torrance will take their battle for the 1966 California Racing Assn. driving title to Ascot Park in Gardena, when they meet in an eight-event sprint car racing program on Monday night, July 4, in a tripleheader program. Racing starts at 8:15 p.m.

Thomas holds a 38½-point lead over Secrist going into this Monday night's 50-lap main event. Thomas has two CRA feature wins this year. Thomas has 386½ points to Secrist's 347, with Jones third with 324 points and two main event wins. Thomas and Secrist will be driving Chevrolet V8 powered cars, while

Jones wheels an Offenhauser powered car. It will be the first Southern California appearance for Jones since he finished second last Sunday afternoon in the USAC sprint car races at New Bremen, Ohio. He'll drive the same Bruce Bromme, Offie from Gardena, in which he flipped twice in his last Ascot outing.

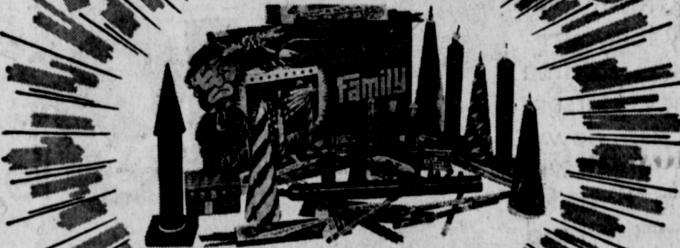
